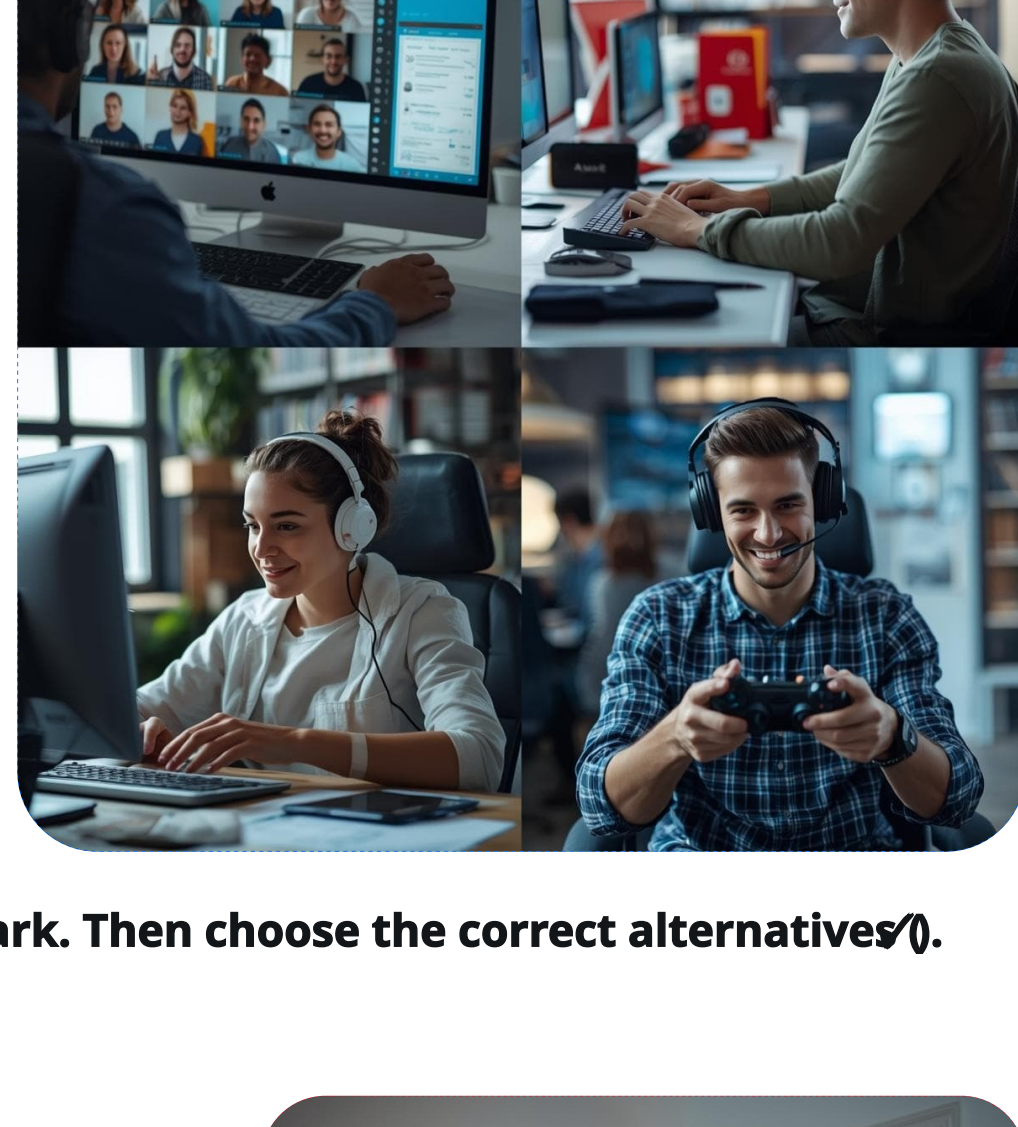

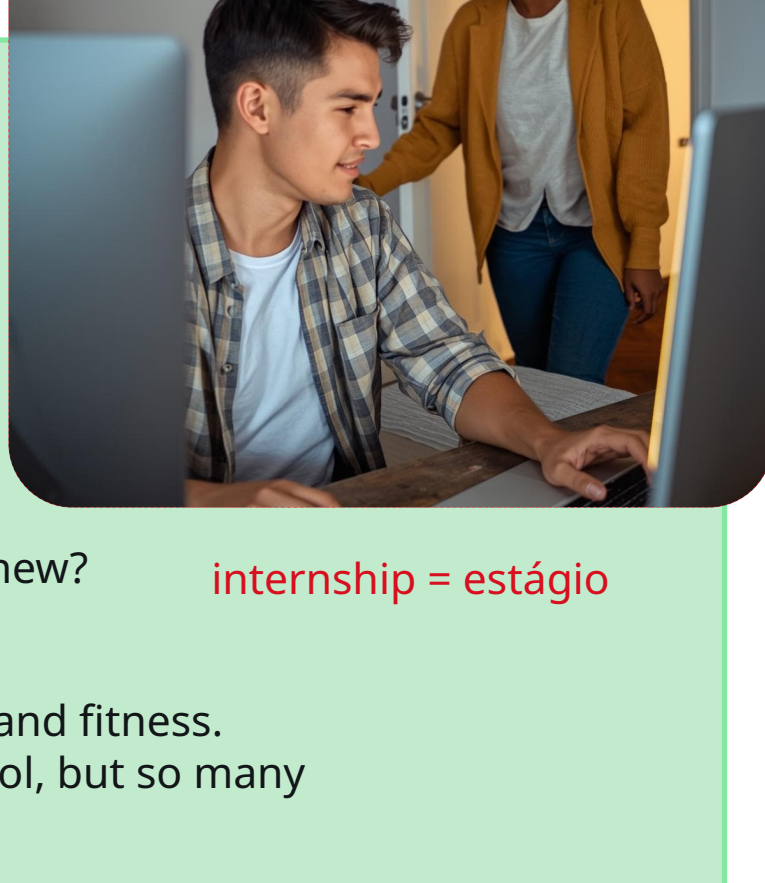

1. Offer Your Skills habilidades

2. Teach What You Know
 If you're good at a subject or skill, you can create video courses or offer tutoring online. With a clear camera and good preparation, you can share your knowledge and earn money doing something you enjoy.
