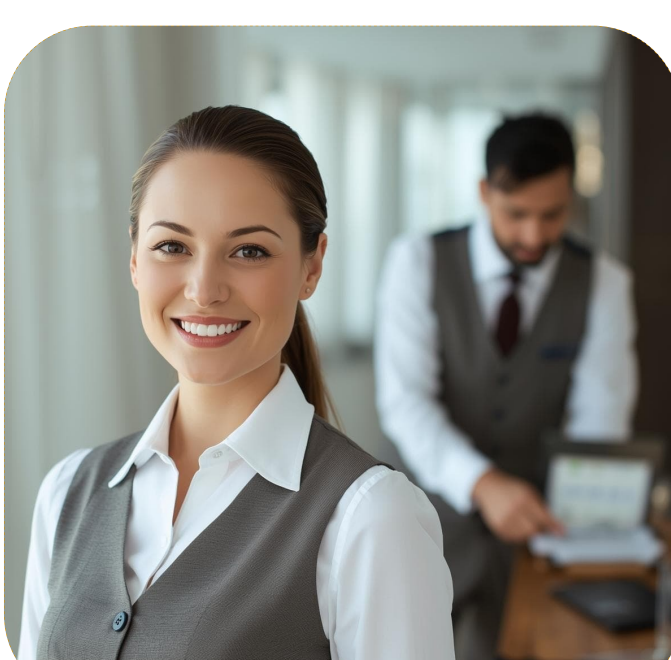
We are going to rent a car at the airport. We need a car to visit different places. We are going to visit Disney World for sure. Sophie says she is going to take a million photos.
